## **Memo: Selection Results from Nominated Farming Groups to Receive Afo-a-kom USA Fertilizer**

**Congratulations** to the farming groups that have been selected to receive fertilizer from Afo-a-kom USA for the 2025 farming season! A total of 70 farming groups were selected from a highly competitive pool of 106 nominated groups from Belo, Njinikom and Fundong. On behalf of our National Executive, I extend sincere appreciation to our Projects committee chair and his entire committee for their diligence and attention to detail, ensuring that at least one group from each of the 45 villages across Kom, represented in the pool of applications, received fertilizer! Thanks to their hard work and the generosity of our donors, about **28,000 kg of fertilizer will be distributed to 2,400 families through 70 farming groups as follows:**

**Belo** – 16 groups; **Njinikom** – 31 groups and **Fundong** – 23 groups

We recognize the challenges faced with nurturing farms to be productive and are honored to play a part in enhancing the productivity and quality of your crops. By collecting this fertilizer, each group/farmer agrees with the following:

1. You will NOT collect Afo-a-kom USA fertilizer from any other group even if you belong to other farming groups.
2. You will NOT sell a single grain of fertilizer from this collection.
3. You will apply the fertilizer to your own farm, and in the manner prescribed by Agric experts.
4. You will bring to our attention anyone who is caught selling or using this fertilizer for any purpose other than applying it to their own farms.

We believe that investing in agriculture is not only essential for economic growth but also crucial for ensuring food security and alleviating poverty in our Kom communities. You are receiving this fertilizer thanks to our volunteers and people of goodwill who donate to Afo-a-kom USA. So, we take feedback and sustainability efforts seriously. We will continue to stay in touch with farming groups through this season to collect information on fertilizer use, the impact, and to learn additional ways we can assist in future.

A big thank you to everyone who nominated a group to receive fertilizer. We appreciate your contributions to the agricultural sector in Kom, and together, we are cultivating a brighter future and helping to lower the cost of basic food items. Even if the group you nominated is not benefiting during this cycle, we will keep you in our thoughts as we look forward to future opportunities. Wishing every farmer a great farming season, bountiful harvests and continued prosperity.
